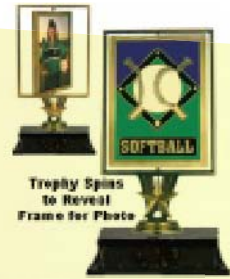


oftentimes thankless, but the kids, parents, and we at Trophies2Go.com appreciate your effort!

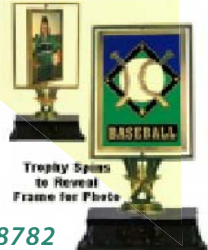


Trophy Spins to Reveal Frame for Photo

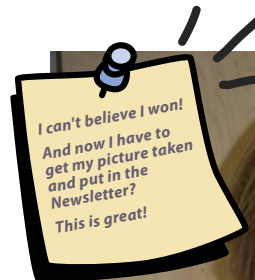
