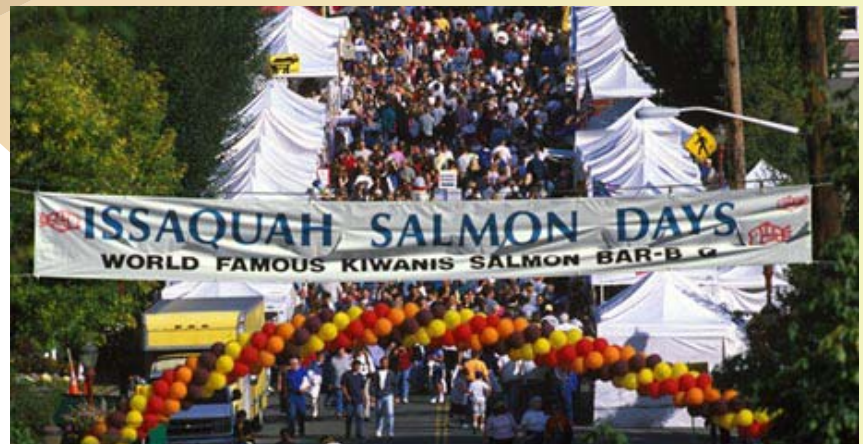

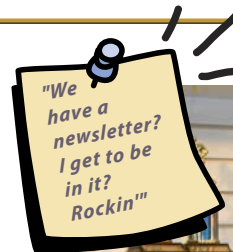
Staff Spotlight
